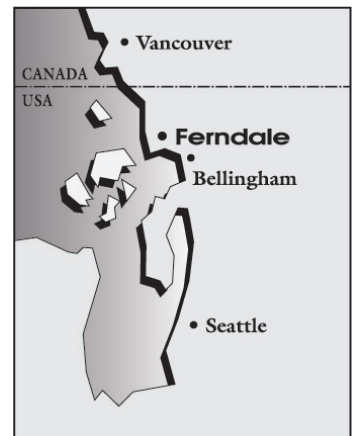
Our Community
